Cover in lightweight tissue. Water shrink flying surfaces, 2 coats of thinned clear dope (complete aircraft) 2 coats colour fuel-proof vulnerable areas



This semi-scale 34" model for .5 - .75 cc. engines is suitable for free flight or radio control. It represents the machine flown by Lt. Warneford to destroy Zeppelin L27 over Belgium. Wings and tailplane are made over the plan. Pin trailing edge and lower spars in position, add ribs then leading edge. Note there is only one centre rib W1. Panels are joined by dihedral keepers D.1. Cover wing with strong tissue. Fit centre kingpost and rigging dowels, all glue tacked in place. Top surface bracing is permanent, with carpet thread or elastic shirring thread. Underside rigging is fitted when ready to fly. Fuselage sub assembly of F1, F2, F3 with bearer and all wire parts fitted is completed before fitting sides, remaining structure including F4 with escapement is added. Be careful with radio installation, check operation of torque rod and rudder before adding fuselage top. Balance where shown by movement of batteries. Finish in dope to obtain scale "creamy" colour, paint markings, finally fuel proof. 2 degrees of right side thrust is advised on the engine.
